### Thursday June 3rd: Bring-a-Dish lunch... or wine, dine and Sime!

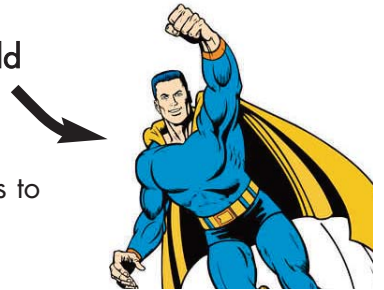
